## **BLACK & WHITE SHROUD PHOTOGRAPHS**

In the past the Society has had some difficulty organizing supplies of black & white prints of the Shroud. Rodney Hoare has, however, now made himself responsible for this particular aspect of the Society's activities, and has quarter plate negatives from which 10 inch by 8 inch prints can be made at a cost of £3.50 per print. The available photographs are:

- (i) Positive of the entire Shroud
- (ii) Negative of the entire Shroud
- (iii) Negative of the Shroud face
- (iv) Positive of the Shroud face

Rodney Hoare points out that where the entire Shroud is required, although the prints will be 10 inches long, they will of course be narrower than 8 inches.
