## The Shroud on the Internet June 2024

<u>L'Arcivescovo Repole dal Papa, videocollegamento per Sindone 2025</u> (Archbishop Repole from the Pope, video-up for Shroud 2025) — Article in *La Voce IL Tempo*, May 23, 2024 - Here is the English translation: "On Wednesday 22 May, on the sidelines of the Assembly of the Italian Episcopal Conference, the Archbishop of Turin Msgr. Roberto Repole was received in private hearing by Pope Francis. In half an hour of friendly interview and updating on the life of the Turin Church, Repole proposed to the Pope to participate in video calling in the Shroud Feast on May 4, 2025, in the jubilee year, when the Shroud will be shown to the young people of the dioceses of Turin and Susa. The Pope welcomed this proposal."

Here is the abstract: "This essay looks at the various versions of Jan van Eyck's depiction of the Holy Face and attempts to provide a new context for understanding." <u>Christ Shroud face from the Turin shroud</u> – Web page by Thierry Speth – November 19, 2023 – Here is a summary from the site: "A couple of years ago I was asked to work on the Turin shroud for a documentary about Jesus Face. I used a 48 bits HQ scan from the shroud. A fourier transformation filter was used to wipe the 49 patterns chevron and clean the scan. Without manipulations, the result is this wonderful face, this means that the shroud not only shows an image but it is also a radar image, a "TOF" modern 3d scan. Not bad for a Piece of cloth. In 1954, a french guy had made a 3d wooden model converting the shades in elevation. In 1976, a first reconstruction was performed in the USA, using a 8 bit computer. Now the 48 bits pictures allow us to see all the depth of the complex Turin Shroud. The only manipulation I allowed

myself was to soften the parts outside the Christ. I have put 3 gcodes, one is very fine, 50 microns (0.05), one is 0.10 and the last one is 0.2. I had to use special retraction parameters to avoid bumps. I tested it on a mecreator2 and an anet 12."
